Please be advised that the County of San Bernardino, Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and accepted a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Report of Composting Site Information (RCSI) for the Victor Valley Regional Composting Facility. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active and closed landfills.

### Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

The Victor Valley Regional Composting Facility is located at 20055 Shay Rd. in Victorville, CA 92394. On June 17, 2020, the LEA received, from the operator of Victor Valley Regional Composting Facility, a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the RCSI.

The changes include the following:

- Updates to the description of the liquid waste receiving procedures and operations.
- Update to the feedstock processing, composting, screening, curing and storage procedures as a result of the completed construction of the Aerated Static Pile (ASP) and processing buildings.
- Update to Table 2: Equipment List.
- Removal of Section 4: Proposed Changes in Design and Operation.
- Updated site map.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA accepted the amendment on July 13, 2020
