Introduction

Please be advised that the San Bernardino County, Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health, Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and accepted a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment for the Transfer Processing Report (TPR) for Sheep Creek Transfer station. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of project and LEA's determination

Sheep Creek Transfer Station is a Large Volume Transfer/ Processing Facility located at 10130 Buckwheat Road, about 2,500 feet north of Phelan Road, in Phelan, CA 92371. The five acre site is located in the unincorporated area of San Bernardino County in Section 16, township 4 North, Range 7 West. The site is designated as a Transfer Station.

On February 13, 2025, the LEA received an RFI amendment application package to revise the TPR to allow 1) verbiage pertaining to the compactor operation, and 2) information pertaining to a new breakroom on site. The TPR revisions were accepted by the LEA on March 14, 2025. The LEA found the proposed changes to be consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents and applicable State Minimum Standards, and do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facility Permit.
